## **Entering Competitors**

Entries for this event will be through the LSV online entry system. Team Managers must enter each team member through the online process. <http://sportlsv.carnival.sls.com.au/eventmgr/sport>

**Please remember to force a Surf Guard update before entering competitors.**

Any competitors who held their relevant age group Competition Skills Evaluation proficiency for the 2015/16 season are able to compete in the first junior carnival at South Melbourne. This is applicable even if they are yet to complete their new age group's Competition Skills Evaluation for this season. Please note that this does not apply for new competitors/members that were not involved in the 2015/16 season.

Existing/returning members will need to complete their relevant Competition Skills Evaluation prior to competing in any remaining Junior Carnivals. Every junior member must participate in a Preliminary Assessment conducted by the club, prior to any junior water activity taking place.

## **Parking Notes:**

Parking will be extremely limited on the event day due to The Carman's Women Fun Run held on the same day.

There is all day free parking on Danks St, Richardson St, Graham St, Rouse St, Philipson St and Beach St. Additionally there is all day paid parking along Beaconsfield Parade, cost is \$12.30 for the full day (see detailed parking map below).

We advise to catch public transport where possible; the #1 South Melbourne Beach Tram may be an option for those who are not bringing gear (nipper board) with them. The last tram stop #32 is opposite the South Melbourne LSC.

Road closures will be in place on Beaconsfield Pde, Jacka Bvd, Marine Pde and Point Ormond Rd between Kerferd Rd and Glen Huntly Rd, between 6.30am and 11.30am. Please note that council parking fees and other restrictions apply. Vehicles parked on the closed roads must not leave until the roads are reopened (approx. 11:30am).
